SUBJECT: Garrison Policy Memorandum #08-05; Priority Services for the 3-85th Infantry Battalion Soldiers, their Family Members, Spouses and Families of Our Fallen

1. In support of the Army Medical Action Plan, and IAW OPOD 07-12 (Mountain Healing), and NETCALL 2008-41: Support for Surviving Spouses and Families, 13 May 2008, Garrison directorates, agencies, and activities are directed to give top priority to the 3-85th Infantry Battalion, Wounded Warrior Support Center (WWSC) Soldiers, their Family members, spouses, and Families of our fallen.
2. Each directorate, agency, and activity will establish an integrated and comprehensive continuum of care and services for the 3-85th Infantry Battalion, WWSC Soldiers, their Family members, and surviving spouses and Families of our fallen in order to provide world class care and services that match the quality of service that these Soldiers, Civilians, and their Families have provided to the Nation.
3. Spouses and Families of our fallen include surviving Family members of Uniformed Service members, Department of Defense Civilians, and Department of the Army Civilians who gave their lives during active Federal service. These services are intended to provide continued needed support for as long as required by these spouses and Family members.
4. The Fort Drum Soldier and Family Assistance Center (SFAC) will coordinate care and services as described above, and be given the appropriate priority as if the 3-85th Infantry Battalion, WWSC, surviving spouse, or Family member were seeking the care and/or services themselves.
5. Additionally, leadership from the above organizations may be required to participate in town hall meetings as necessary.
