SUBJECT: FT Drum Public Works Engineer Troop Operations Annual Training Support for FY09

1. PURPOSE. To provide Engineer Troop Units with information regarding Troop Operations support and services.

2. INFORMATION.

a. A list of projects is available, on request, for FY09 and out years. Contact the troop construction operations office through the POC below. This list will provide vertical and horizontal construction projects. The intent is to provide a variety of METL training for all types of engineer units.

b. Project folders are available that include project work order number, detailed estimates, plans and specifications, BOM, REC form, quality control plan, and various forms for record keeping and mission controls.

c. METL objectives supported include: construction and repair of wood, concrete, and steel structures; and clearing and grubbing, cut and fill, paving, rock crushing, and road maintenance operations.

d. The 411 EN BD has established a Construction Cell to support the troop construction program by providing some long term project planning, project design, estimates, project folder development, supervision, quality control, and quality assurance. Project completion is emphasized.

e. Projects should be selected no later than 01 February 2008. However, later selections may be accommodated if materials/BOM can be made available before the projected start date. If more than one unit is interested in a project, the Troop Construction Office will make the final decision on assignment.

3. CONCLUSION. To assure project readiness, planning and coordination are essential. The Troop Operations office is open Monday through Thursday 0700-1630, and Friday 0700-1530.
