


Army Environmental Management System (EMS)



- EMS integrates environmental stewardship into the overall management of an Army installation and provides a structure for achieving the installation's environmental goals.
- EMS addresses the installation's organizational structure, planning activities, responsibilities, practices, procedures, processes and resources as they relate to the environment.
- 4-step model— Plan, Do, Check, Act
- Promotes the Army's commitment to excellence and leadership that results in sustaining the Mission, preventing pollution, complying with regulations and self assessment & improvement.
- Fort Drum EMS focuses on improved solid waste management. EMS objectives include development of a comprehensive solid waste management plan and diversion of 50% of the non-hazardous solid waste stream from disposal in local landfills by 30 September 2015. Also, implement controls and procedures to manage petroleum, oils and lubricants. Report Spills to 911.





I NEED TO DISPOSE OF:
COMMON HOUSEHOLD TRASH/GARBAGE
RECYCLABLES: newspaper, junk mail (magazines, paperback books), office paper, shredded paper, metal (food containers, tins, mixed metal), aluminum (foil, takeout containers, food and beverage containers), glass, plastics #1,2,3,4,5,6, and 7 (milk jugs, product bottles, product packing), egg cartons & brown wrapping paper. Clean Cardboard (clean product packaging without wax coating) and corrugated cardboard. NO styrofoam.
HAZARDOUS WASTE (Non-rechargeable batteries (NICAD, lithium), fluorescent light bulbs, curly-cue light bulbs, paint, thinners, cleaners, solvents, pesticides, propane cylinders, aerosols, C2/C2A1 canisters, expired materials, etc.)
WOOD PALLETS/SKIDS
INSTITUTIONAL ELECTRONIC WASTE (Computers, TV, small scale servers, computer peripherals [cables, cords, wiring], monitors, keyboards, mice or similar pointing devices, facsimile machines, document scanners, printers, DVRs, portable music players, DVD, blue-ray players, digital converter boxes, cable or satellite receivers, electronic or video game consoles & peripherals [controllers etc.], cellular phones, digital cameras)
REFRIGERATORS & OTHER WHITE GOODS
USED DRY SWEEP, PETROLEUM SLUDGES, PETROLEUM CONTAMINATED SOILS
USED OIL FILTERS
USED OIL
ANTIFREEZE
PARTS WASHER FLUID
BULK WASTE (non-palletized wood, furniture, mattresses and other bulk waste)
BATTERIES (NYS law requires rechargeable batteries to be recycled. Rechargeable batteries placed in the trash is a fineable offense.)
5-CENT RETURNABLE BOTTLES & CANS (NYS includes Carbonated Soft Drinks (Sparkling Water), Carbonated Energy Drinks, Carbonated Juice (anything less than 100% juice, containing added sugar or water), Soda Water, Beer and Other Malt Beverages, Mineral Water - Both carbonated and non-carbonated mineral water, Wine Products, Bottled Water (incl. flavored not containing sugar)
PHARMACEUTICALS: PERSCRIPTION, OVER-THE-COUNTER MEDICATIONS & MEDICAL SHARPS/WASTE

MOTOR POOLS & INDUSTRIAL/COMMERCIAL AREAS
Discard trash in dumpsters.
Public Works Recycle & Refuse pick up recyclables on a scheduled basis, special pickups by request (315-772-6445). 24 Hour Self-Serve Recycling Drop-off Center Bldg. 1152. The following should be bagged separately for collection: plastics, metal and glass together, shredded paper, junk mail (incl. magazines, paperback books), office (white) paper, colored paper & newspaper. Please place broken down cardboard in appropriate CARDBOARD ONLY dumpsters. There are over 150 throughout the installation. If you need a cardboard only dumpster in your area please call PW Refuse & Recycling at 315-772-5944.

No automotive work is allowed in residential areas or in parking lots on post.

Rechargeable batteries (nickel cadmium, lithium ion, nickel metal hydride and other dry cell rechargeable batteries) are now accepted at most retailers. Eligible batteries can be turned in at the Hazardous Waste Storage Facility Bldg. 11144 Tues. 1100-1300 or Thur. 1200-1400 (315-772-4156). Common alkaline non-rechargeable batteries can be placed in with trash.
DO NOT place in trash. Redeem your cans & bottles in machines at local retail stores and redemption centers. At a minimum please place in appropriate recycling containers. Can be recycled in appropriate curbside recycling centers.
