DO NOT BRING PERSONAL WASTE ON POST!






I NEED TO DISPOSE OF:
COMMON HOUSEHOLD TRASH/GARBAGE
RECYCLABLES: newspaper, junk mail (magazines, paperback books), office paper, shredded paper, metal (food containers, tins, mixed metal), aluminum (foil, takeout containers, food and beverage containers), glass, plastics #1,2,3,4,5,6, and 7 (milk jugs, product bottles, product packing), egg cartons, brown wrapping paper, clean cardboard (clean product packaging without wax coating) and corrugated cardboard. NO styrofoam.
HAZARDOUS HOUSEHOLD WASTE (Fluorescent light bulbs, curly cue light bulbs, paint, thinners, cleaners, solvents, pesticides, propane cylinders, aerosols, non-rechargeable batteries [NICAD, lithium], automotive fluids, nail polish & remover, perfume, hand sanitizer)
USED MOTOR OIL PRODUCTS
PHARMACEUTICALS: PERScription, OVER-THE-COUNTER MEDICATIONS & MEDICAL SHARPS/WASTE
BATTERIES (NYS law requires rechargeable batteries to be recycled. Rechargeable batteries placed in the trash is a fineable offense.)
AUTOMOTIVE BATTERIES
E-Waste (Computers, TV, small scale servers, computer peripherals [cables, cords, wiring], monitors, keyboards, mice or similar pointing devices, facsimile machines, document scanners, printers, small electronics equipment, DVRs, portable music players, DVD, blue ray players, digital converter boxes, cable or satellite receivers, electronic or video game consoles & peripherals [controllers etc.], cellular phones, laptops [including their batteries], digital cameras
TIRES
ANTIFREEZE (automotive, RV, etc.)
SCRAP METAL
PLASTIC GROCERY BAGS
5-CENT RETURNABLE BOTTLES & CANS (NYS includes Carbonated Soft Drinks (Sparkling Water), Carbonated Energy Drinks, Carbonated Juice (anything less than 100% juice, containing added sugar or water), Soda Water, Beer and Other Malt Beverages, Mineral Water - Both carbonated and non-carbonated mineral water, Wine Products, Bottled Water (incl. flavored not containing sugar)

Take all pharmaceuticals (prescription and nonprescription) to Guthrie Pharmacy, Bldg. P-11050 off Mt. Belvedere, for free turn-in. Monday through Thursday 0800-1700 and Friday 0800-1200. (315-772-3696). For medical sharps (needles, diabetes lancets, etc.) you may get a sharps container from the Guthrie Pharmacy. Sharps containers can be turned into the Guthrie Pharmacy when full and exchanged for a new one.
Rechargeable batteries (nickel cadmium, lithium ion, nickel metal hydride and other dry cell rechargeable batteries) are now accepted at most retailers. For local participating locations go to CALL2RECYCLE.ORG . Receptacles for rechargeable batteries will be placed in all community centers or can be turned in at the Hazardous Waste Storage Facility Bldg. 11144 Tues. 1100-1300 or Thur. 1200-1400 (315-772-4156). Non-rechargeable alkaline batteries can be placed in with trash.
Recycle automotive batteries at an auto care store, Firestone Complete Auto Care Bldg. 11110 (315-773-8025) or exchange your car battery at the retailer when you purchase a new one.
Turn-in at the Solid Waste Transfer Station Bldg. 11001. Hours of Operation 0700-1430 Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday & Friday. Most toner and ink cartridges from printer, copiers and fax machines can be turned in for recycling with LCI-SSSC Bldg. 1100, Ontario Ave (315-773-3121).
All tire retailers are required by New York State law to accept used tires for proper disposal & recycling. A fee may be charged for this service.
No automotive work is allowed in residential areas. Antifreeze can be turned in at the Auto Care Bldg. 11110 (315-773-8025) or the Hazardous Waste Storage Facility Bldg.11144 Tues. 1100-1300 or Thur. 1200-1400 (315-772-4156).

SINGLE SOLDIER HOUSING
Discard trash in dumpsters.
