

# FORT DRUM 2004-2005 ARCHERY QUALIFICATION



All archers hunting on Fort Drum must demonstrate their shooting ability by attending an archery qualifying session. Archers fulfilling qualification requirements will receive a Fort Drum Archery Qualification Card which must be in the archer's possession while hunting on Fort Drum. Archers must re-qualify every year before hunting on Fort Drum.

Archers may qualify from the ground or from an elevated structure approximately 10 feet high, by shooting three out of five arrows equipped with **BROADHEADS** in the vital area of life-size 3-D deer targets. **Military and civilian DoD personnel that plan to hunt in Fort Drum's cantonment area are required to qualify from the elevated structure.**

Five targets will be placed at unknown distances between 0-25 yards with 10, 20, and 30-yard markers present. Only one qualifying shot will be allowed at each target.

Archers failing to qualify on their first attempt may try again, but only at a later qualifying session. **No practicing will be allowed at the qualification site.**
