

Updated! College Scholarships for Fort Drum Soldiers & Families

- **North Country Spouses Club Scholarship**
 - Eligibility: Spouses and Children of active duty or retired active duty military (*Officer and Enlisted*) – applications available at the Education Center in early Spring <http://northcountryspousesclub.com>
- **Military Order of the Purple Heart Scholarship**
 - Eligibility: Purple Heart recipient, Spouse and Children –21 January deadline scholarship@purpleheart.org
- **Rotary Purple Heart Scholarship**
 - Eligibility: Members assigned to the 10th Mountain Division who have been awarded the Purple Heart while the division was stationed at Fort Drum, or their dependents – 1 April deadline on most applications www.nnycf.org
- **Horatio Alger Military Veterans Scholarship**
 - Eligibility: Service in the U.S. military in the Iraq/Afghanistan theater beginning in 2001 or later – www.horatioalger.com
- **National Military Family Association's Joanne Holbrook Patton Military Spouse Scholarship Program**
 - Eligibility: a Uniformed Services Spouse – www.nmfa.org
- **Army Emergency Relief – AER Scholarship Programs**
 - Eligibility: Dependent Children Scholarship; Stateside Spouse Scholarship; and Overseas Spouse Scholarship Applications are accepted from 2 January to 1 May of each year – www.aerhq.org
- **ThanksUSA Scholarship**
 - Eligibility: All dependent children, age 24 and under and all spouses of active duty military – Applications are accepted each year from 1 April to 15 May -www.thanksusa.org
- **Scholarships for Military Children Program – Fisher House**
 - Eligibility: Under- 23, children of active duty, Reserve/Guard and retired military personnel – 13 February deadline - www.militaryscholar.org
- **Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW) – Youth Scholarship Programs**
 - Eligibility: Varied depending on the specific scholarship –30 April deadline - www.vfw.org
- **The American Legion Scholarship Programs**
 - Eligibility: Varied depending on the specific scholarship – www.legion.org
- **Military Officers Association of America Scholarship**
 - Eligibility: Under-24, children of MOAA members and children of active duty, Reserve, National Guard, or retired enlisted military personnel – www.moaa.org
- **Army Aviation Association of America, Inc. (AAAA) Scholarship Program**
 - Eligibility: Current members of the AAAA, and the spouses, unmarried siblings, unmarried children and grandchildren of current and deceased members – www.quad-a.org
- **Northern New York Community Foundation Scholarships**
 - Eligibility: Varied depending on the specific scholarship – www.nnycf.org
- **Jefferson Community College (JCC) Foundation's Nontraditional Student Scholarships**

- **Columbia College’s Spouse’s Opportunity Scholarship**

- **U.S. Army Women’s Foundation Legacy Society Scholarship**
 - Eligibility: Applicant must be a woman who has served or is serving honorably in the U.S. Army, Reserve, and National Guard or is the child of a woman who served honorably in the Army, Reserve or National Guard. Postmark deadline is 15 January - www.awfdn.org
- **New York State Veterans Tuition Award**
 - Eligibility: NY State residents discharged under other than dishonorable conditions from the U.S. Armed Forces and are:
 - Vietnam Veterans who served in Indochina between 12-22-61 & 5-7-75
 - Persian Gulf Veterans who served in the Persian Gulf on or after 8-2-90
 - Afghanistan Veterans who served in Afghanistan on or after 9-11-93www.veterans.ny.us
- **AFCEA Educational Foundation Scholarships**

Eligibility: U.S. military veterans or active-duty personnel are eligible. www.afcea.org/education/scholarships/military
- **10th Mount Division Association**

Seven awards of up to \$5,000 per year. 1 April deadline. www.nnycf.org
- **Raytheon Patriot Scholarship**

Three awards at \$10,000 for military veterans studying cybersecurity and engineering. 1 February deadline. <https://www.studentveterans.org> (bachelors/masters/PhD)
- **Tillman Military Scholarships**

Vets, active duty service members working on an undergraduate or graduate degree whose education benefits have run out or insufficient to meet their needs. www.pattillmanfoundation.org
- **AMVETS National Scholarships for Veterans**

Working fulltime on undergraduate, graduate or certification from an accredited trade or technical school. Education benefits must be exhausted and is based on financial need, academic promise, and military duty and awards etc. \$1,000/year for up to four years. www.amvets.org/programs/scholarships/html
- **Imagine America Military Award Program**

For veterans and military personnel interested in attending a participating career college. Open to active duty, reservists and honorably discharged and retired veterans. Must have access to tuition assistance and government-supported financial aid through the GI Bill and other programs. Applications submitted online to the college where the student wishes to enroll. \$1,000/year. June deadline each year. www.imagine-america.org.
